Job Description

DEFINITION

Works with special education students who are exhibiting problems that interfere with the implementation of the goals and objectives of their IEPs. Develops strategies that will weaken or reduce identified problem behaviors. Teach strategies that strengthen or increase appropriate behaviors. This is a year to year position contingent on special education funding.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES

- Develop proactive strategies to assist and support special education students who display problem behaviors.
- Direct observation of students exhibiting problem behavior.
- Review available data such as assessment reports prepared by other professionals and other student records.
- Collect data, analyze data, and write functional analysis assessments
- Collaborate with school psychologists, teachers, administrators, instructional aides, and counselors to collect and analyze behavioral observation data and assist in the writing of behavior plans.
- Work with school personnel to implement the behavior plan.
- Ongoing monitoring of behavior plans.
