ROTC Instructor (Navy) Job Description

DEFINITION

As part of a secondary teaching assignment, teaches one or more classes of NJROTC to pupils in grades 9-12, and assists in other school programs as assigned. This is a Navy instructor's position. It requires a Navy commissioned or non-commissioned officer who possesses a valid standard designated subjects teaching credential in ROTC and who has been certified as a high school ROTC instructor by the Navy ROTC through any of the ROTC Regional Headquarters.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES

Administer and manage the NJROTC program effectively according to law, regulations, policies, and principles.
Actively recruit students to join NJRTOC.
Achieve desired learning goals by teaching prescribed NJROTC subjects listed in the Program of Instruction.
Maintain proficiency in military subjects taught.

Knowledge of:

NJROTC program policies and regulations.
