DEFINITION

As a part of a secondary teaching assignment, teach one or more classes in the field of science to students in grades 7 and 8, assist in other school programs as assigned, and create a flexible program and environment favorable to learning and personal growth in accordance with each student's ability.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES

- Teach scientific knowledge, skills, attitudes, and rational thinking processes though courses in general science, earth science, biology, chemistry, physics, and other science related courses
- Instruct students in citizenship, basic communication skills, and other general elements of the course of study specified in state law and administrative regulations and procedures of the school district.
- Plan an interesting, well balanced science instructional program involving lectures, discussions, laboratory experiences, and audio-visual presentations.
