EDUCATION PROTECTION ACCOUNT**

June 3, 2015

The voters approved Proposition 30 on November 6, 2012. Proposition 30 added Article XIII, Section 36 to the California Constitution. The provisions of Article XIII, Section 36(e) create in the state general fund an Education Protection Account (EPA) to receive and disburse revenue derived from the increase in tax rates that will be made available for transfer into the EPA this fiscal year. The school district shall have sole authority to


